Statement: Key points

- Express awareness of, and support for, the aims of the Community Outgrower and Protection scheme, including Production-Protection Agreements (PPAs*).
 - Financially support the commencement of a community outgrowers' scheme, strongly linked to protection of the forest and benefits to communities.
- Support practical actions to establish an initial 2,000-4,000 ha of outgrower development linked to forest protection agreements commencing in 2016.
- Beginning as a pilot project in which oil palm companies and communities will test community outgrower models and Production-Protection Agreements (PPAs);
- Leading to COP schemes and PPAs that are effective and acceptable to all parties and which can be scaled up, so many communities can benefit from outgrower schemes and so that local and national objectives for conserving forest can be met.
- With the Government of Liberia and other organizations contributing staff time, knowledge, cross-governmental coordination for land use planning;
- and the application of relevant programs that can assist the communities with sustainable agriculture, community forestry, biodiversity conservation, sustainable community economic diversification and other needs.
