- Major private and public sector players have pledged to present a Joint Framework of Action to end deforestation and forest degradation in the cocoa sector
- COP 23 in Bonn in November 2017

- By organizing a series of Roundtables an inclusive process is designed to develop the Joint Framework of Action
 - Round Table 1: general input
 - Round Table 2: input based on first draft
 JFA
 - Round Table 3: share provisional JFA
- TWG provides detailed review of draft JFA
- National Steering Committee steers JFA drafting and validates final JFA content
- IDH / WCF in the lead on facilitation of the process together with the Coordination Team
