# What is expected of you as a processor

For your products to be recognized as sustainable, you must be able to map the upstream supply chain of your products up to farm level. If the product is not segregated, you will be required to provide an explanation of your mass balance system (with a declaration assuring the sustainability status).

### At farm level

Anystandardthathasbeenbenchmarked by SAI/FSA as "bronze equivalent". The most common standards are below, please download the full list or visit fsatool.com. SAI FSA bronze (3rd party audited), Global Gap in combination with FSA add-on, Rainforest Alliance / SAN, Fairtrade, Fair for Life, Rural Horizons Brasil Citrus, Unilever Sustainable Agriculture Code, SIZA, UTZ.

## At processing level

A sustainability certification or verification that is at least equivalent to ETI/SMETA 4-Pillar or SA8000.
